ORDINANCE No. 108.

A bill for an ordinance in relation to the rate to be charged for water furnished by the City of Hopkins.

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins as follows:

Section 1. For all water furnished by the City of Hopkins a mimimum charge of Seventy Five (75) cents per month shall be charged for each meter and Two Thousand (2,000) gallons of water may be used and for each additional One Thousand (1,000) gallons of water, or part thereof, a charge of Twenty Five (25) cents shall be made, providing payment is made on or before the 10th day of the succeeding month, and if not paid to the city collector on or before the 10th day of such succeeding month the mimimum charge shall be one Dollar, and Thitty (30) cents per thousand Gallon or part thereof for each Thousand gallon or part thereof over Two Thousand gallon, and if not paid during such succeeding month the water shall be turned off, and regular charges shall be made for turning it on again.

Section Two. Where any manufactory or shop of any kind, or business of any kind shall use more than Twenty five Thousand (25,000) gallons of water in any month, such manufactory, shop or business shall be furnished water at Thirty (30) cents per One Thousand Gallon during the months in which over Twenty five Thousand (25,000) gallos of water shall be used, and in other months the rate as mentioned in section One hereof shall be charged.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
