The City Att'y then offered A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE, Leving the Poll Tax in the City of Hopkins. for the year 1916.

On motion made, and seconded that this ordinance, be placed upon its First reading, this motion prevailed and it was read as followes.

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Hopkins, as follows:

All male persons the age of Twenty One and Fifty Years, who have resided in the corporate limits of the City of Hopkins, for Thirty days prior to passage of this Act, are hereby required to work on the streets and alleys, of said City Two days, for the year 1916, or in lieu thereof, to pay to the Street Commissioner, the sum of Two Dollars. (\$2.00) and if said work is not done at the time and place at and for which notice is given by the Street Commissioner, the said Two Dollars, shall become immediately due, and payable, and suit shall be brought for the Collection thereof according to law, and the City attorney shall be allowed a fee of Five Dollars for bringing such suit, which fee shall be taxed as costs against the defendent, in such suit against whom judgment is rendered.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approveal.
