AN ORDINANCE repealing the sub-section entitled "Special Provisions" of Section 4 of Ordinance No. 278 and enacting in lieu thereof a new "Special Provisions" sub-section of Section 4 relating to the same subject matter, and providing for a license tax.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen
of the of , Missouri, as
follows:
SECTION 1 - That the sub-section entitled "Special Provisions" of
Section 4 of Ordinance Number be and the same is hereby re-
pealed, and that a new "Special Provisions" sub-section of Section 4 of Ordinance
Number be enacted in lieu thereof relating to the same sub-
ject matter, and providing for a license tax, which shall read as follows:
SPECIAL PROVISIONS:
The foregoing Items A, B, C, D and E of this overhead light-
ing schedule are only applicable provided:
(1) That the Company is serving the City
under the terms of an electric franchise. In case the Company
shall at any time furnish overhead street lighting service to the
without the existence of an electric franchise,
all overhead lighting shall be charged for in accordance with the
net rates respectively set out in Items B, D and E.
(2) That the Company shall pay to the City
a license tax which shall be a sum equal to five per cent (5%) of the
gross receipts of the Company from the sale of electrical energy
for residential and commercial purposes within the limits of the
; that such taxes herein required to be paid
by the Company shall be in lieu of any other franchise, license, oc-
cupation, excise or merchandising tax, but shall not be in lieu of
any ad valorem tax.

(3) In case the Company shall at any time furnish overhead
street lighting service to the under an obligation to
pay a franchise or license fee or tax in excess of such tax speci-
fied in Paragraph (2) above, all overhead lighting shall be charged
for in accordance with the net rates respectively set out in Items C,
D and E.
(4) All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are in con-
flict herewith, insofar as they so conflict, are hereby repealed.
(5) That within ten (10) days after the passage and approval
of this ordinance the St. Joseph Light & Power Company shall file
its written acceptance of this ordinance with the Clerk of the
City of Hopkins , Missouri, and
unless such written acceptance is so filed within said ten days, this
ordinance shall be null and void.
(6) If this ordinance is accepted by the St. Joseph Light &
Power Company, as provided in Paragraph 5, above, this ordinance
shall take effect and be in force on and after July 1, 1958.
